

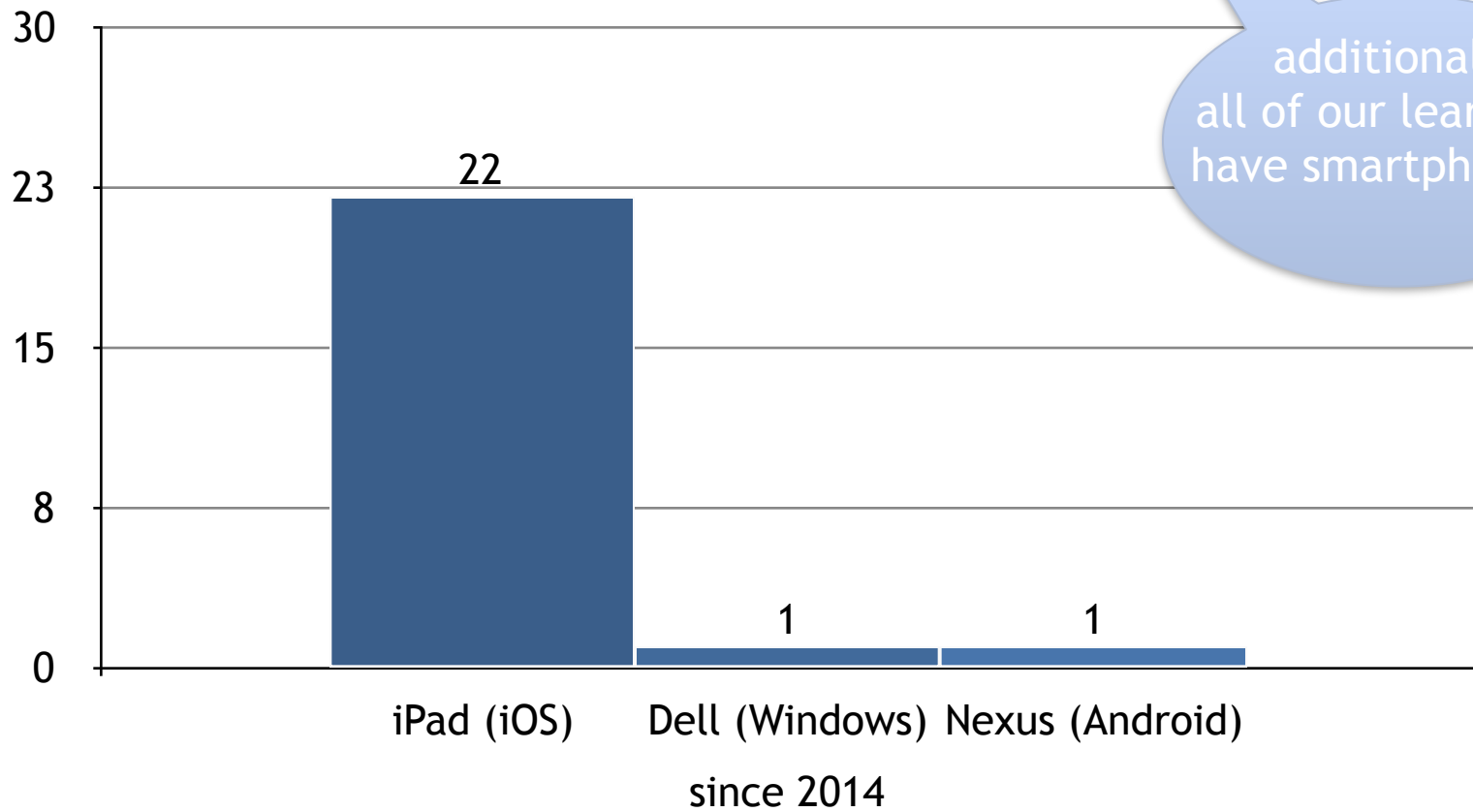


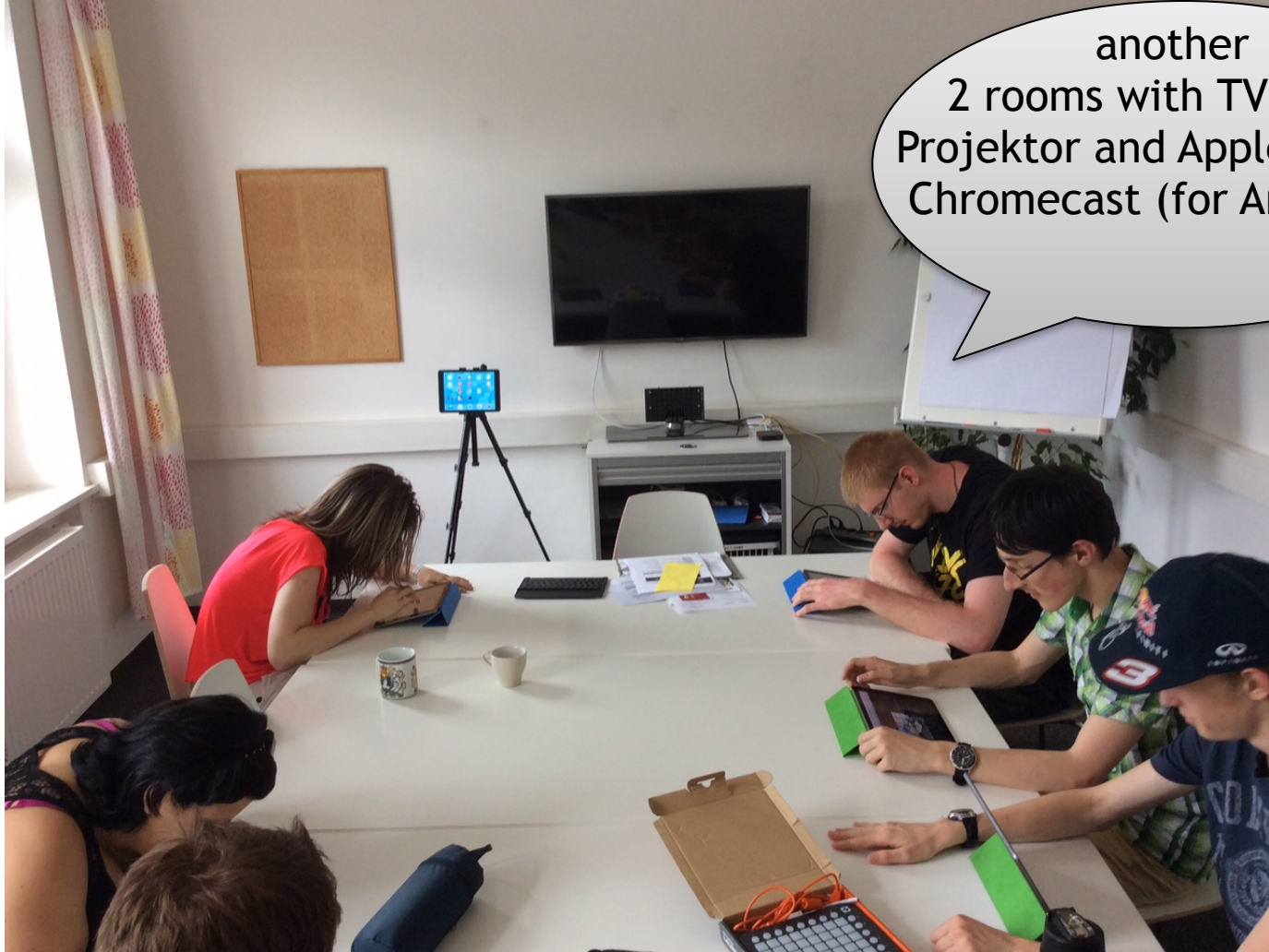
Device Managment - our experiences

- » since 2 years tablets for different purposes (Foto, Video, learning apps, selfmanagement, documentation, tutorials...)

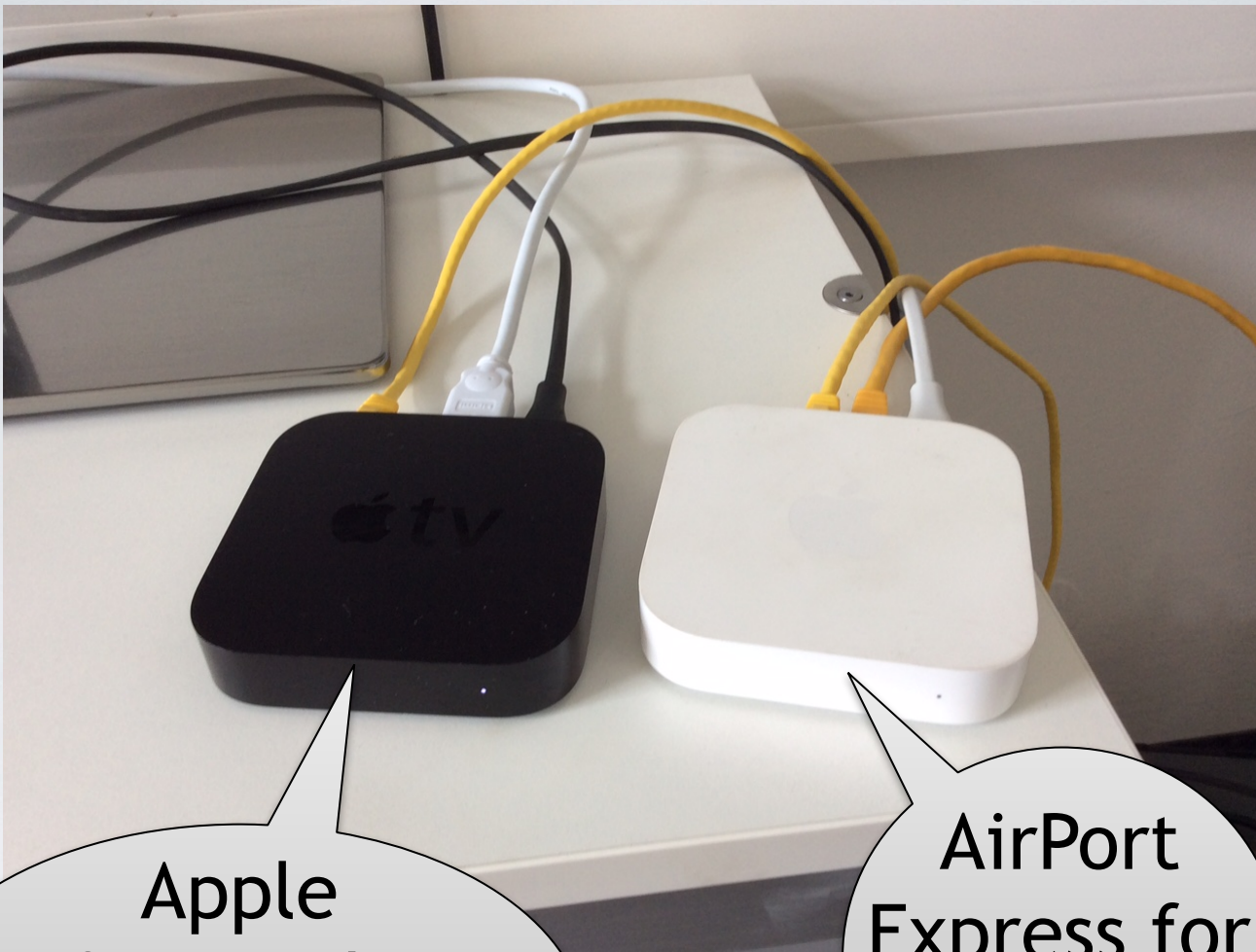

Requirements for device management

- » Storage
- » Purchase and allocation Apps
- » Storage
- » Backup
- » Restrictions
- »

BYOD

- » Bring Your Own Device means that user own the device
- » User are responsible for their devices
- » User buy apps and store the data on their devices - sometimes common storage as well
- » Devices can be integrated in a central device management (including restrictions)

versus UOD

- » Use Our Device: schools own the devices
- » Schools are responsible for purchase and management
- » They care about storage
- » Easier to set restrictions

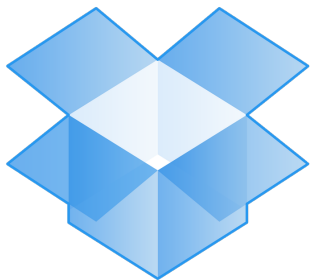

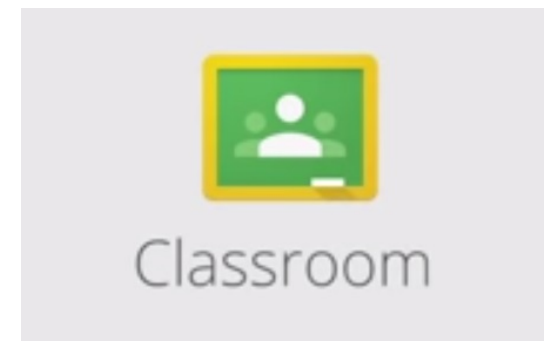
