

How to Learn Maths


Using the calculator

1. Tap on the **Calculator** –app.

The MyScript Calculator opens.




2. Touch the screen with your finger and draw the numbers you want to calculate.



4. The app will change your drawing into real numbers and calculation symbols.


5. The app will make the calculation.

The correct answer will appear on the screen.



6. If you want to erase the calculation, tap on the **Dustbin**-button.



Now the screen is empty and you can continue counting.



Settings

You can change your calculator's settings.

1. Tap on the **MyScript**-button.
MyScript menu will open.
2. Tap on **Settings**-button.




3. Settings will open.

Now you can deactivate the automatic calculation -feature, if you want to.

It will make your calculator not to count automatically.

4. Tap on the **Automatic calculation** -button.




5. Tap on the **Back**-button.

6. Tap on the screen.

Now you will see


Calculate-button
