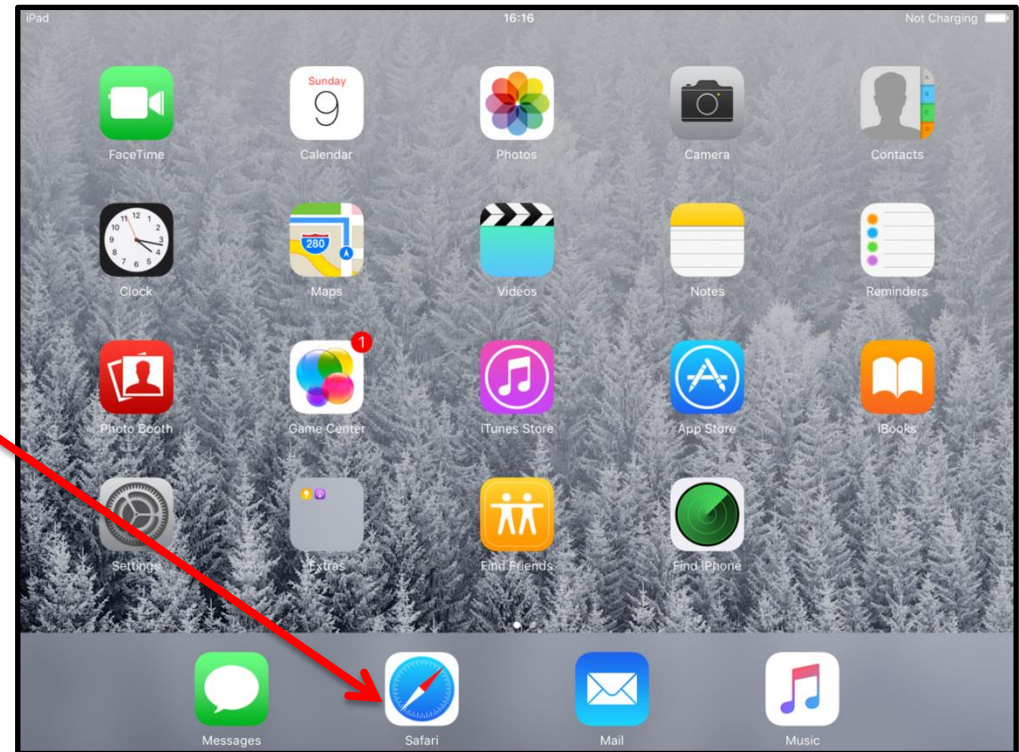
How to surf on the internet

Open Safari

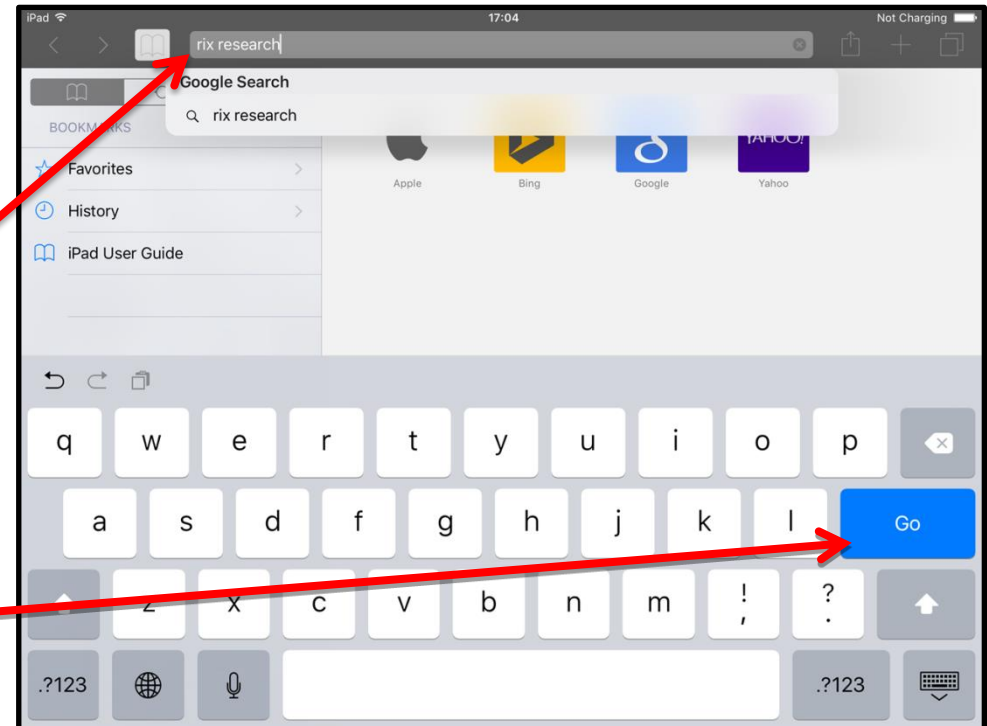
1. Tap on the Safari-app on the screen.
2. Safari will open and now you can start to use internet.

Safari is the default internet browser of the iPad.



Surfing the internet

1. Tap on the Search bar.
2. Write a search word or words or the internet address.
3. Tap on **Go**-key.



4. Now you will see the results of your search.

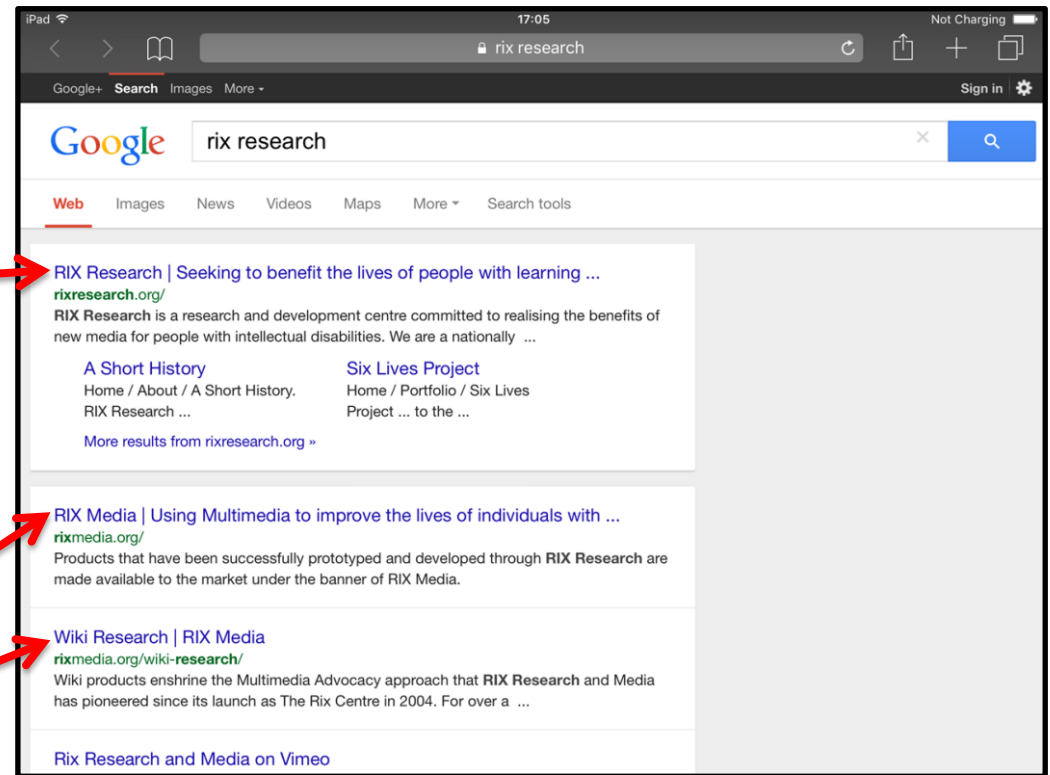
5. Tap on the name of the website you want to open.

Notice:

On this page you will see a list of different results of the search.

They are called links.

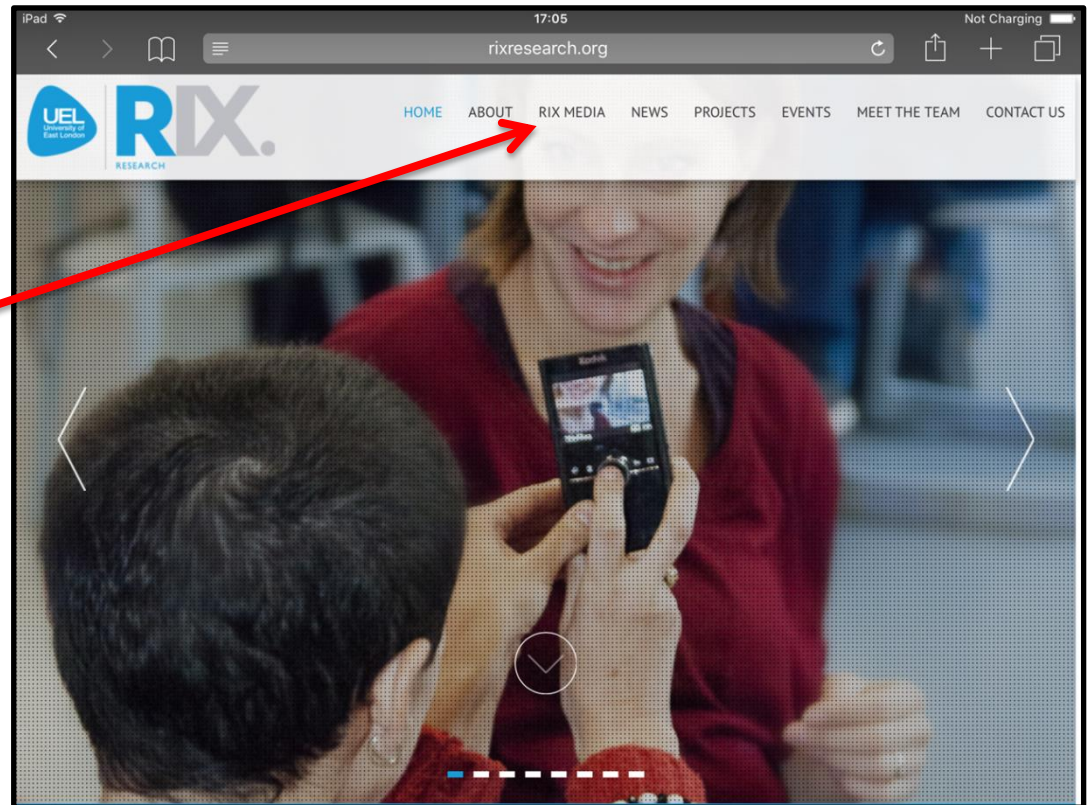
Links will always take you to another page or open a website.



6. The page will open.

Now you can start reading
the information on the website.

You can also tap on
one of the links
and read more information.

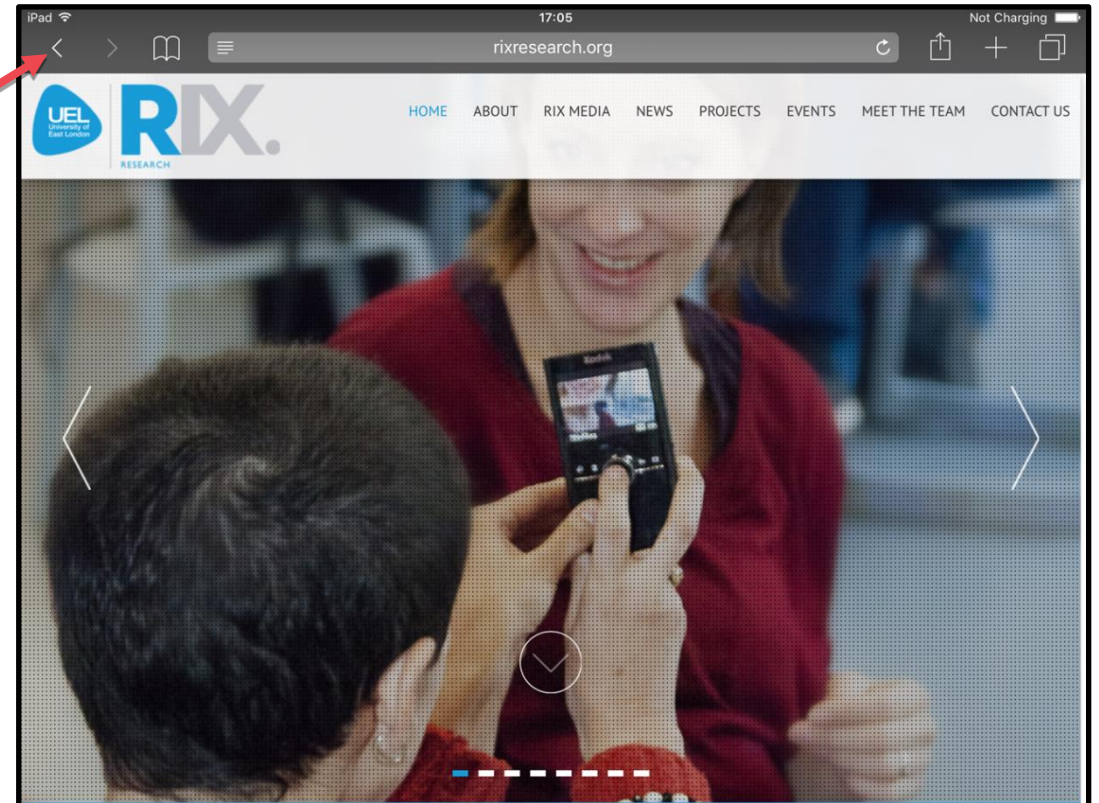


7. If you want to go back to the previous page.

Tap on the arrow pointing left.
